## Economics of the Construction Step

The standard AIA breakdown of Basic Service Fee allocates 20% of the total fee to Construction Administration. Based on our Basic Service Fee of 6.7% and the proposed Construction Cost of \$1,500,000 the fee would be \$100,500. 20% allocated for Construction Administration is \$20,100. One third of the fee is set aside for Consultants leaving **\$13,500** for the architect. Here is how our portion of the fee is allocated among Construction Administration Tasks. The assumed duration of construction is 10 months.
